STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, Making Appropriation for the Maine Agricultural
Experiment Station for the Purchase of Additional Land at
Highmoor Farm.

Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated for
2 the year ending June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twen-
3 ty-six the sum of three thousand dollars to be expended by
4 the Maine Agricultural Experiment Station for the purchase
5 of additional land for Highmoor Farm, so-called, in the
6 Town of Monmouth.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The State Farm at Highmoor in the Town of Monmouth is seriously handicapped in its work and investigations by lack of land particularly for the carrying on of experiments in orcharding, since much of the land in the original purchase is not suitable for orcharding.

It is now possible to purchase some thirty or forty acres of the adjoining Grosser estate which by location and character of soil is particularly suited to meet the needs of the farm and the Station.

It is the unanimous opinion of the Station Council that this purchase should be made as soon as possible and an option has been secured.
