STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, Making Appropriation for the Control and Suppression of the European Corn Borer.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the 2 sum of seven thousand five hundred dollars for each of the 3 fiscal years nineteen hundred and twenty-six and nineteen 4 hundred and twenty-seven for the control and suppression 5 of the European Corn Borer, to be expended under the 6 direction of the Commissioner of Agriculture.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This resolve provides for the continuance of the campaign for control and suppression of the European Corn Borer and constitutes the only fund available for that purpose. It is for the same amount as was allowed by the eighty-first legislature for the same purpose. Valuable results have been obtained and for the protection of our corn growers, it is absolutely necessary that the appropriation be continued.
