STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, Making an Appropriation for the Maine Seed Improvement Association.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the 2 sum of one thousand dollars for the fiscal year from July 3 one, nineteen hundred and twenty-five to June thirty, nine-4 teen hundred and twenty-six, and the sum of one thousand 5 dollars for the fiscal year from July one, nineteen hundred 6 and twenty-six to June thirty, nineteen hundred and twenty-7 seven, to be paid to the Maine Seed Improvement Asso-8 ciation.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

For many years the State has appropriated One Thousand Dollars annually for the Improvement of the quality and varieties of seed grown and used by our farmers, this money being paid out principally in the form of prizes for the best exhibits of Maine grown seeds of all kinds at the annual meeting of the Pomological Society, Maine Seed Improvement Association and the Maine Dairymen's Association.

The Seed Improvement Association has no other income.

The Resolve is for the same amount as appropriated for several years past.
