STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Repeal the Bounty on Bears.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

All acts or parts of acts providing for payment of a bounty
2 on bears killed in the State of Maine are hereby repealed.
