STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Extend the Charter of the Quebec Extension Rail-
way Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. *P. & S. L., 1913, c. 41; 1915, c. 56; 1917, c. 2 15; 1919, c. 6; 1921, c. 12; 1923, c. 20; charter Quebec Ex- 3 tension R. R. Co. extended.* The rights, powers and privi- 4 leges of the Quebec Extension Railway Company, which 5 were granted by chapter forty-one of the private and spe- 6 cial laws of nineteen hundred and thirteen, and extended 7 by chapter fifty-six of the private and special laws of nine- 8 teen hundred and fifteen, and extended by chapter fifteen 9 of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred and

10 seventeen, and extended by chapter six of the private and
11 special laws of nineteen hundred and nineteen, and extended
12 by chapter twelve of the private and special laws of nine-
13 teen hundred and twenty-one, and extended by chapter
14 twenty of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred
15 and twenty-three, are hereby continued in force and ex-
16 tended for two years from the time this act goes into ef-
17 fect, and all the rights, powers, privileges and franchises
18 which were granted, or have been acquired by virtue of said
19 act, may, and shall be exercised in the same manner and
20 for the same purpose as provided in said chapter forty-one,
21 except as hereinafter provided.

Sect. 2. *Existing statutes not repealed; rights conferred*
2 *subject to R. S., c. 55.* Nothing herein contained is intended
3 to repeal, or shall be construed as repealing, the whole or
4 any part of any existing statute, and all the rights and duties
5 herein mentioned shall be exercised and performed in ac-
6 cordance with all the applicable provisions of chapter fifty-
7 five of the revised statutes, and all acts amendatory thereof
8 or additional thereto.
