STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Amend Chapter One Hundred and Ten of the
Private and Special Laws of the Year Nineteen Hundred and
Nine, Relating to the Good Will Home Association.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section One of Chapter four hundred and fifty-five of the
2 Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-
3 seven as amended by chapter one hundred and ten of the
4 Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and nine is
5 hereby amended by striking out the words "twelve hundred
6 thousand" in the last clause of said section and substituting
7 in the place thereof the words 'five million,' so that said
8 section as amended shall read as follows:

'Section 1. The Good Will Home Association, a charitable
2 corporation formed under the provisions of Chapter fifty-
3 five of the Revised Statutes, for the purpose of aiding needy
4 boys, and located at East Fairfield in Somerset County, is
5 hereby authorized to take and hold by purchase, gift, devise
6 or bequest, personal or real estate in all not exceeding five
7 million dollars owned at any one time.'
