#### STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Regulate Fishing in the Portion of Moose River Above Brassua Lake, in the County of Somerset.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to fish for

- 2 take, catch or kill any kind of fish in that portion of Moose
- 3 river above Brassua lake, in the county of Somerset, after
- 4 the fifteenth day of August of each year except in the ordi-
- 5 nary way of casting with unbaited artificial flies, or fly
- 6 fishing, so-called.

It shall also be unlawful for any person to have in posses-

- 2 sion at any time any kind of fish taken in violation of any
- 3 provision of this section.

The provisions of this section shall not be construed as 2 applying to Long pond, so-called, or Wood pond, so-called, 3 or Attean pond, so-called.

- Sect. 2. Whoever violates any provision of this act shall 2 be subject to a penalty of not less than ten dollars nor more 3 than thirty dollars and costs for each offense and a further 4 penalty of one dollar for each fish taken, caught, killed or 5 had in possession in violation of any provision of this act.
- Sect. 3. In all prosecutions arising under this act, trial 2 justices, police and municipal courts within their counties 3 shall have, upon complaint, original and concurrent jurisdiction with the supreme judicial court and superior courts.
