STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Open Indian Pond in the County of Somerset to
Ice Fishing for the Months of February, March and April.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. During the months of February, March and
2 April in each year, it shall be lawful for any one family to
3 fish for and take, in any one day, not more than ten pounds
4 of landlocked salmon, trout and togue, through the ice in
5 Little Indian Pond, in Squaretown, in the county of Somer-
6 set, with not more than five set lines to such family, and
7 when under the immediate personal supervision of the per-
8 son fishing, and may convey the same to their own homes
9 for consumption therein.

Sect. 2. All acts and parts of acts of any public or private
2 and special laws inconsistent herewith, so far as the same
3 relate to the subject matter of this act, are hereby repealed.
