STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT in Relation to Itinerant Vendors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 26 of Chapter 41 of the Revised Statutes of Maine
2 is hereby amended by striking out the last ten words of said
3 section, to wit, the words "nor to hawkers on the streets or
4 pedlers from vehicles," so that that section as amended
5 will read as follows:

'Sect. 26. Persons exempt. R. S. c. 45, 16. The provi-
2 sions of the fifteen preceding sections shall not apply to
3 sales made to dealers by commercial travelers or selling
4 agents in the usual course of business, nor to bona fide sales

5 of goods, wares and merchandise by sample for future de-
6 livery.'
