STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Salary of Sheriff of Piscataquis County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section forty-one of chapter one hundred seventeen of the 2 Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter two hundred four-3 teen of the public laws of nineteen hundred nineteen, as 4 amended by chapter two hundred nineteen of the public 5 laws of nineteen hundred twenty-one, and as amended by 6 chapter one hundred six of the public laws of nineteen 7 hundred twenty-three, is hereby amended by striking out 8 the words, "Piscataquis, one thousand dollars" in the fif-9 teenth line thereof, and inserting in place thereof, the fol-10 lowing: 'Piscataquis, thirteen hundred dollars,' so that said 11 section as amended, shall read as follows:

HOUSE-No. 228

'Sect. 41. Salary in Piscataquis County increased to 2 \$1,300.00. The Sheriffs of the several counties shall re-3 ceive annual salaries from the treasuries of the counties in 4 monthly payments paid on the last day of each month, as 5 follows:

'Androscoggin, twenty-five hundred dollars,

'Aroostook, twenty-five hundred dollars,

'Cumberland, four thousand dollars,

'Franklin, one thousand dollars,

Hancock, sixteen hundred dollars,

'Kennebec, twenty-eight hundred dollars,

'Knox, twelve hundred dollars,

'Lincoln, eight hundred dollars,

'Oxford, twelve hundred dollars,

'Penobscot, twenty-eight hundred dollars,

'Piscataquis, thirteen hundred dollars,

'Sagadahoc, fifteen hundred dollars,

'Somerset, fourteen hundred dollars,

'Waldo, twelve hundred dollars,

'Washington, fourteen hundred dollars,

'York, twenty-five hundred dollars,

Together with free rental of the house or living apartment 2 connected with the county jail in each county, including the 3 necessary light and fuel. Said salaries shall be in full com-4 pensation for services in attendance upon the supreme judi-5 cial court, and upon the superior courts in the counties of 6 Cumberland and Kennebec as jailer, master or keeper of the 7 jail in each county, for receiving and committing prisoners 8 therein and for the service of all criminal processes and the 9 performance of all duties relating to the enforcement of all 10 criminal laws. Such necessary incidental expenses as are 11 just and proper, incurred in the performance of their public 12 duties including all necessary expenses for aid in keeping 13 the jails, shall be allowed by the respective boards of county 14 commissioners of said counties, and paid from county 15 treasuries.'
