**STATE OF MAINE**

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE

AN ACT to Provide for the Better Protection of Clams Within  
the Limits of the Town of Perry.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Limited to Residents. It shall be unlawful for  
2 any person not a resident of the town of Perry, in the  
3 county of Washington, to dig clams for commercial purposes  
4 within the limits of said town.

Sect. 2. Non-residents may dig clams for bait or home  
2 consumption; limit one bushel. Persons not residents of  
3 the town of Perry may be permitted to dig for clams for  
4 fish bait or home consumption within the limits of said  
5 town; provided, however, that no person shall dig for pur-

6 poses mentioned in this section during any one day more  
7 than one bushel of clams.

Sect. 3. Penalty for violation. Whoever violates the pro-  
2 visions of sections one and two of this act shall for each  
3 offense be punished by a fine not exceeding twenty-five  
4 dollars, or by imprisonment for not more than thirty days.
