RESOLVE, in Favor of Newell Gabriel, Representative of the
Penobscot Tribe of Indians.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated to
2 be paid to Newell Gabriel, representative of the Penobscot
3 tribe of Indians at the eighty-second session of the legis-
4 lature, one hundred sixty-five dollars for attendance and
5 eighteen dollars for mileage.
