STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT in Favor of the Monson Maine Slate Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The Monson Maine Slate Company, a corporation organized under the laws of the commonwealth of Massachusetts, and having a place of business and quarries in Monson, in the county of Piscataquis in the state of Maine, and its successors and assigns, is hereby granted the right for a period of fifty years from the time this act takes effect to quarry, mine and remove slate for a distance not exceeding two thousand feet under Lake Hebron in said Monson, from the slate vein which is a continuation of the vein now owned by said Monson Maine Slate Company; said quarry

11 to be by means of a subterranean tunnel and in no other
12 manner and shall be so conducted as not to interfere with
13 the waters of said Lake Hebron.
