STATEMENT OF FACTS

The State of Maine holds in trust for the Passamaquoddy Tribe of Indians a considerable sum of money, the interest of which is used for their support with such additional sums as may from time to time be required by the Tribe for educational purposes, relief of the poor, and distressed, sickness, repair of buildings, salaries of tribal officers, etc.

This resolve provides the usual funds necessary for these purposes during the two-year period ending June 30th, 1927, and is for the same amount appropriated for a similar period ending June 30, 1925.
