STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Prohibiting Fishing in the Tributaries to St. Croix
Lake, in Townships Seven and Eight, Range Four, Aroostook
County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to fish for,
2 take, catch or kill any kind of fish at any time in any of the
3 tributaries to St. Croix lake, which lake is situated in town-
4 ships seven and eight, range four, Aroostook county.

It shall also be unlawful for any person to have in posses-
2 sion at any time any kind of fish taken in any of said tribu-
3 taries.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any provision of this act shall

2 be subject to a penalty of not less than ten nor more than
3 thirty dollars and costs for each offense, and an additional
4 penalty of one dollar for each fish taken, caught, killed or
5 had in possession, in violation of any provision of this act.

Sect. 3. Trial justices, police and municipal courts, within
2 their respective counties, shall have, upon complaint, orig-
3 inal and concurrent jurisdiction with the supreme judicial
4 court and superior courts in all prosecutions arising under
5 this act.
