IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Establish Daily Limit on Fish in C Pond, in Town-  
ship C Surplus, Oxford County.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to take,  
2 catch and kill, or have in possession, in any one day, more  
3 than ten fish in all in C pond, so-called, which pond is sit-  
4 uated in Township C Surplus, in the county of Oxford.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any provision of this act shall  
2 be subject to a penalty of not less than ten nor more than  
3 thirty dollars and costs for each offense, and an additional  
4 penalty of one dollar for each fish taken, caught, killed or  
5 had in possession, in violation of any provision of this act.

Sect. 3. Trial justices, police and municipal courts, within  
2 their respective counties shall have, upon complaint, orig-

3 inal and concurrent jurisdiction with the supreme judicial  
4 court and superior courts in all prosecutions arising under  
5 this act.
