IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Liens for Personal Services in Harvesting Potatoes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Whoever labors in harvesting potatoes has a lien on all

- 2 the potatoes harvested by him and his colaborers for the
 - 3 amount due for his personal services, which takes precedence
- 4 of all other claims except liens reserved to the state, con-
- 5 tinues for thirty days after the last of such services and
- 6 may be enforced by attachment.
