STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Provide for the Licensing of Persons Erecting
and Installing Awning in the State.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. No person without a state license shall engage
2 in or carry on the business of marketing, selling, installing
3 or repairing awnings which when installed may extend from
4 the building to which the same may be attached over any
5 public street, public sidewalk or highway within the state
6 of Maine.

Sect. 2. Upon every such license to carry on such business
2 there shall be charged and collected by the treasurer of state
3 the sum of three hundred dollars and the license shall there-
4 upon be issued by the secretary of state.
