STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relative to the Appointment of Administrators,
Guardians, Conservators and Receivers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter 68 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by
2 adding thereto the following section, to be known as Sec-
3 tion 74.

'Sect. 74. No trust or banking company, association or
2 institution, incorporated under the laws of this state or of
3 any other state, and doing business in this state, shall act
4 or do business as administrator, guardian, conservator or
5 receiver, within the state; anything in their charter to the
6 contrary notwithstanding. All other acts and parts of acts
7 inconsistent with the provisions hereof, are hereby repealed.'
