STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Increasing the Salary of the Register of Deeds in
the County of Lincoln.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section forty-three of chapter one hundred and seventeen
2 of the revised statutes as amended by chapter two hundred
3 and fourteen of the public laws of nineteen hundred and
4 nineteen, as amended by chapter two hundred and nineteen
5 of the public laws of nineteen hundred and twenty-one, as
6 amended by chapter one hundred and four of the public
7 laws of nineteen hundred and twenty-three, is further
8 amended by striking out in the thirteenth line thereof the
9 words "Lincoln, one thousand dollars" and inserting in

10 place thereof the words 'Lincoln, fourteen hundred dollars,'
11 so that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 43. Registers of deeds of the several counties shall
2 receive annual salaries from the treasuries of the counties
3 in monthly payments paid on the last day of each month,
4 as follows:

Androscoggin, fifteen hundred dollars,

Aroostook, northern registry, one thousand, southern reg-
2 istry eighteen hundred dollars,

Cumberland, twenty-five hundred dollars,

Franklin, eleven hundred dollars,

Hancock, fifteen hundred dollars,

Knox, twelve hundred and fifty dollars,

Lincoln, fourteen hundred dollars,

Oxford, eastern registry twelve hundred dollars, western
2 registry eight hundred dollars,

Penobscot, two thousand dollars,

Piscataquis, twelve hundred dollars,

Sagadahoc, fourteen hundred dollars,

Somerset, eighteen hundred dollars,

Waldo, one thousand dollars,

Washington, thirteen hundred and fifty dollars,

York, fifteen hundred dollars.

The sums mentioned shall be in full compensation for the
2 performance of all their official duties and no other fees
3 or compensation shall be allowed them. All registers, ex-
4 cept the western district of Oxford county, shall devote

5 their entire time to the duties of the office. They shall
6 account quarterly under oath to the county treasurers for
7 all fees received by them or payable to them by virtue of
8 the office, specifying the items, and shall pay the whole
9 amount of the same to the treasurers of their respective
10 counties quarterly on the first days of January, April, July
11 and October of each year. They may make abstracts and
12 copies from the records and furnish the same to persons
13 calling for them and may charge a reasonable fee for such
14 service, but shall not give an opinion upon the title to real
15 estate. Fees charged by them for abstracts and copies shall
16 be retained by them and not paid to the county.'
