STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relative to Clerk Hire in the Office of Registry of
Deeds for Lincoln County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Paragraph Nine of Section Forty-five of Chapter One
2 Hundred and Seventeen of the Revised Statutes as amended
3 by paragraph three of section two of Chapter two hundred
4 and sixty-one of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and
5 nineteen is hereby amended by striking out the word "four"
6 in the first line of said paragraph and inserting in place
7 thereof the word 'six,' so that said paragraph as amended
8 shall read as follows:

'LINCOLN COUNTY: for clerk hire in the office of
2 register of deeds six hundred dollars; for clerks in the office

3 of register of probate one hundred and sixty dollars; for
4 clerks in the office of clerk of courts two hundred dollars *
