IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

---

AN ACT Relating to the Salary of the Clerk of the Lewiston Municipal Court.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter one hundred and twenty-eight of the private and  
2 special laws of nineteen hundred and twenty-one, as amend-  
3 ed by chapter twenty-three of the private and special laws  
4 of nineteen hundred and twenty-three, is hereby amended  
5 by striking out the words "eighteen hundred," and inserting in  
6 place thereof, the words, 'twenty-one hundred,' so that said  
7 section as amended, shall read as follows:

'Section 1. The clerk of the municipal court for the city  
2 of Lewiston shall receive an annual salary of twenty-one

3 hundred dollars, with ten hundred and forty dollars addi-  
4 tional for clerk hire from said city in monthly payments,  
5 which sum shall be in full compensation for the performance  
6 of all duties required of said clerk by law. He shall account  
7 quarterly under oath, to wit, on the first days of January,  
8 April, July and October of each year, to the treasurer of  
9 the city of Lewiston, for all fees received by him by virtue  
10 of his office, specifying the items, and shall pay the whole  
11 amount of the same to the treasurer of the city of Lewiston  
12 quarterly on the days aforesaid.'
