STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Authorize Harry M. Stanley to Construct and Maintain a Wharf and Boathouse in Lake Maranacook in Winthrop.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Harry M. Stanley, his associates and assigns are hereby
2 authorized and empowered to construct, maintain and con-
3 trol a boat house and wharf in the waters of Lake Marana-
4 cook in the town of Winthrop, the same to be located at
5 some point not less than seventy-five feet north from the
6 north side of the bridge across Mill Stream, so-called, on
7 Bowdoin street, nor more than one hundred and fifty feet

8 north of said bridge, provided he or they shall first obtain
9 the consent of the owners of the shores of the lake to which
10 said wharf and boat house are adjacent, or the consent of
11 the municipal officers of said town, in case said location of
12 such wharf and boat house are adjacent to any highway or
13 townway. In no case shall the wharf obstruct the channel
14 or extend more than 100 feet into the lake from high water
15 mark.
