STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Amend Section Thirty-eight of Chapter One Hundred Seventeen of the Revised Statutes, Relating to Compensation of Judges of Probate.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section thirty-eight of chapter one hundred seventeen of
2 the revised statutes as amended by chapters one hundred
3 fifty-two, one hundred sixty-seven, and two hundred ninety-
4 two of the public laws of nineteen hundred seventeen; by
5 chapter two hundred fourteen of the public laws of nine-
6 teen hundred nineteen; by chapter two hundred nineteen
7 of the public laws of nineteen hundred twenty-one, and by
8 chapters twenty and forty-four of the public laws of nine-

9 teen hundred twenty-three, is hereby further amended by
10 striking out the words "five hundred dollars" in the twelfth
11 line of said section and inserting in place thereof the words,
12 'seven hundred dollars,' so that said section so far as it
13 relates to the salary of the judge of probate of Lincoln
14 county shall read as follows:

'Lincoln, seven hundred dollars.'
