STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relative to an Increase in the Salaries of the Judge
and Recorder of the Millinocket Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section fifteen of chapter three hundred and ninety-three
2 of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred nine,
3 as amended by chapter two hundred twenty of the private
4 and special laws of nineteen hundred thirteen, and as fur-
5 ther amended by chapter nineteen of the private and spe-
6 cial laws of nineteen hundred and fifteen, is hereby fur-
7 ther amended by striking out the word "eight" in the second
8 line and inserting in place thereof the word 'twelve'; also
9 by striking out the word "four" in the third line and in-

10 serting in place thereof the word 'six,' so that said section
11 as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 15. The judge shall receive a salary, in full for all
2 services, of twelve hundred dollars per annum to be paid
3 him by the county of Penobscot, and the recorder a salary
4 of six hundred dollars per annum, payable quarterly.'
