IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Provide for the Collection of Assessments from the Mortgagee in Interest.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
That whenever a mortgagee requests that a fire insurance
2 policy be made payable to him in case of loss, to the extent
3 of his mortgage interests, that he thereby assumes and guar4 antees to pay any subsequent assessment not paid by the
5 assured upon receipt of written notice to him from the
6 insurance company.
