STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Providing for Recovery by Log Drivers of Damages
Caused by Storage Dams.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Whenever the cost of driving logs, wood or lumber on
2 any floatable stream is increased by a storage or reservoir
3 dam, an action to recover such additional cost may be main-
4 tained by the owner of such logs, wood or lumber against
5 the owner of such dam. Such action shall be brought in
6 the supreme judicial or superior court in the county where
7 such dam is located.
