STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Permit Towns to be Divided into Polling Districts for the Election of Municipal Officers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section twelve of chapter seven of the revised statutes as
2 amended by chapter two hundred five of the public laws
3 of nineteen hundred seventeen, and as further amended by
4 chapter two hundred seven of the public laws of nineteen
5 hundred twenty-one, is hereby made applicable in all its
6 provisions to and in any town which has accepted the pro7 visions of chapter seventy of the public laws of nineteen
8 hundred twenty-one, relative to the election of town officer9 by secret ballot.
