STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to the Regulation of Fishing in the Inland
Waters of Maine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

There shall be no restrictions placed upon fishing in any
2 rivers, streams, lakes, or ponds in Maine except such as
3 are placed thereon by an act of the legislature, and any
4 power or authority hitherto exercised by the commissioner
5 of inland fish and game in placing restrictions upon fishing
6 in the rivers, streams, lakes and ponds of this state, is here-
7 by taken away.
