#### STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to the Salary of the Judge of Probate of Waldo County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section thirty-eight of chapter one hundred and seventeen 2 of the revised statutes, as amended by chapters one hundred 3 and fifty-two, one hundred and sixty-seven, and two hundred and ninety-two of the public laws of nineteen hundred 5 seventeen; by chapter two hundred and fourteen of the 6 public laws of nineteen hundred and nineteen, by chapter 7 two hundred and nineteen of the public laws of nineteen

- 8 hundred twenty-one, and by chapter forty-five of the public
- 9 laws of nineteen hundred twenty-three, is hereby further

10 amended by striking out in the eighteenth line thereof the
11 words "seven hundred dollars" and inserting in place there12 of the words 'one thousand dollars,' so that said eighteenth
13 line, as amended, shall read as follows:

'Waldo, one thousand dollars.'
