STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Increase the Salary of the Clerks in the Office of the Register of Probate for Oxford County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

That so much of the paragraph in section forty-five of chapter one hundred and seventeen of the revised statutes as refers to salaries of clerks in the office of the register of probate for Oxford County, as amended by chapter two hundred and thirty-six of the public laws of nineteen hundred and seventeen, and as further amended by chapter two hundred and nineteen of the public laws of nineteen hundred and twenty-one, is hereby further amended by striking out the words "four hundred dollars" and inserting in the

10 place thereof the words 'five hundred and twenty dollars,'
11 so that said section forty-five of chapter one hundred and
12 seventeen, as amended, shall read as follows, viz.,

'Oxford County. For clerks in the office of register of
2 deeds, six hundred and twenty-four dollars, and such addi-
3 tional amount as may be authorized by the county com-
4 missioners; for clerks in the office of register of probate,
5 five hundred and twenty dollars; and for clerks in the office
6 of clerk of court, six hundred dollars.'
