IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Amend Section Fifteen of Chapter Fifteen of the Private and Special Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Twenty-three, Relating to the Salary of the Recorder of Kennebunk Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter fifteen of the private and special laws for the
2 year nineteen hundred and twenty-three is hereby amended
3 by striking out in the third line of section fifteen thereof
4 the word "three," and inserting in place thereof the word
5 "four," so that said section, as amended, shall read as fol-
6 lows:

'Sect. 15. The judge shall receive a salary in full for all

2 services of six hundred dollars per annum to be paid him
3 by the county of York, and the recorder a salary of four
4 hundred dollars per annum, payable quarterly.'
