STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Extend the Charter Granted to the Salisbury Cove Water Company, for the Taking of Water from Lake Wood, and Furnishing Water to the Village of Salisbury Cove for Two Years.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The act of incorporation of the Salisbury Cove

- 2 Water Company, being chapter forty-nine of the private
- 3 and special laws of nineteen hundred and fifteen, and ex-
- 4 tended for two years under chapter eighteen of the private
- 5 and special laws of nineteen hundred and seventeen, and
- 6 extended for two years under chapter thirty-five of the
- 7 private and special laws of nineteen hundred and nineteen,

8 and extended for two years under chapter seventy-three of 9 the private and special laws of nineteen hundred and twen10 ty-one, and extended for two years under chapter nineteen
11 of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred and
12 twenty-three, is hereby further extended for two years from
13 the date when this law becomes effective, with the same
14 force and effect in all respects as if said incorporation were
15 hereby granted.

Sect. 2. Nothing herein contained is intended to repeal, 2 or shall be construed as repealing, the whole or any part of 3 any existing statute, and all rights and duties herein men-4 tioned shall be exercised and performed in accordance with 5 all the applicable provisions of chapter fifty-five of the re-6 vised statutes and acts amendatory thereof or additional 7 thereto.
