STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to the Taking of Smelts from Cobscook River, Cobscook Bay, Orange River, Denny's River and Their Tributaries.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. No smelts shall be caught, taken or fished for
2 between the first day of April and the first day of Septem-
3 ber in each year in the waters of Cobscook river, Cobscook
4 bay, Orange river, Denny's river or any of the bays, coves
5 or tributaries of the same, but the catching, taking or fishing
6 for smelts by nets in said waters during the month of Sep-
7 tember shall not be deemed illegal. Nothing in this act shall
8 apply to smelts taken in fish weirs or traps maintained and
9 operated for the catching of sardines and herring.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates the provisions of this section shall pay a fine of one hundred dollars for each offense.

Sect. 3. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent herewith, so far as the same relate to this act, are repealed.
