RESOLVE, in Favor of Ann M. Hiltz of Newburg, for State
Pension.

Resolved: That there be paid to Ann M. Hiltz of New-
2 burg, the sum of six dollars per month, payable quarterly
3 from the fund appropriated for soldiers' pensions, beginning
4 January one, nineteen hundred and twenty-five and continu-
5 ing during the pleasure of the legislature.

This lady is blind. She has no property and no means of support. She has no relatives able to take care of her. Her nearest relatives are two nieces, one of whom has a large family and whose husband gets his living by day work; the other is also poor and unable to support this party.
