STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Provide for Clerk Hire in the Office of Sheriff of Androscoggin County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: In accordance with section forty-five of chapter one hun-2 dred and seventeen of the revised statutes and acts addi-3 tional thereto and amendatory thereof, the treasurer of the 4 county of Androscoggin shall pay weekly for clerks em-5 ployed in the office of the sheriff of the county of Andros-6 coggin, the sum of six hundred (\$600)⁻ dollars as wages 7 and shall take individual receipts therefor. The sheriff of 8 the county of Androscoggin shall certify to the county treas-9 urer of the county of Androscoggin the names of his clerks

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10 and the weekly wages at which they may be employed. Such 11 clerks shall be allowed a vacation not to exceed two weeks 12 in any one year without loss of pay and no clerk shall re-13 ceive more than eighteen (\$18) dollars per week. Author-14 ity is hereby given to the sheriff of the county of Androscog-15 gin to employ clerical assistance in his office and the county 16 treasurer of the county of Androscoggin is authorized to 17 pay said clerks as hereinbefore set forth in this act. And 18 said section forty-five and acts additional thereto and 19 amendatory thereof is hereby amended by providing for 20 clerks, and for clerk hire in the office of the sheriff of the 21 county of Androscoggin in the sum of six hundred (\$500) 22 dollars.
