STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to the Equipment of Electric Cars with Head Lights.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

All electric cars which are operated upon rails, which lie

- 2 wholly or in part within the limits of any way or highway,
- 3 shall be equipped with three lights upon the front thereof,
- 4 one white light in the center and one green light and one
- 5 red light on the sides of such white light.
