STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Appropriations for Advertising by Cities and Towns.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section fifty-nine of chapter four of the revised statutes,

- 2 as amended by chapter eighty-seven of the public laws of
- 3 nineteen hundred and seventeen, is hereby further amended
- 4 by inserting before the word "such" in the fourth line, the
- 5 words 'the state or,' so that said section as amended shall
- 6 read as follows:

'Sect. 59. Any city or town may appropriate any sum, 2 not exceeding one mill on a dollar, based on the valuation 3 of the preceding year, to be expended and used for adver-

- 4 tising the natural resources, advantages and attractions of
- 5 the state or such city or town.'
