STATE OF MAINE

**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE**

**AN ACT to Amend an Act to Incorporate the Hallowell Water
District.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section two of chapter seventy-five of the
2 private and special laws of nineteen hundred and twenty-one
3 is hereby amended by inserting after the word "authorized"
4 in the second line thereof the following: 'to divert and use
5 water from Jimmie's Pond, so-called, situate in the towns of
6 Farmingdale and Manchester, and to increase the storage
7 of said pond,' so that said section, as amended, shall read
8 as follows:

'Sect. 2. The said district, for the purposes of its in-

2 corporation, is hereby authorized to divert and use water
3 from Jimmie's Pond, so-called, situate in the towns of
4 Farmingdale and Manchester, and to increase the storage of
5 said pond, to take and hold, as for public uses, by purchase,
6 eminent domain, or otherwise, any land or interest therein,
7 or water rights necessary for erecting and maintaining dams,
8 for flowage, for power for pumping its water supply through
9 its mains, for reservoirs, for preserving the purity of the
10 water and the water shed, for laying and maintaining aque-
11 ducts and other structures, for taking, distributing, dis-
12 charging and disposing of water and for rights of way or
13 roadways to its source of supply, its dams, power stations,
14 reservoirs, mains, aqueducts, structures and land.'

Sect. 2. Section four of said chapter seventy-five of the
2 private and special laws of nineteen hundred and twenty-one
3 is hereby amended by striking out the word "the" following
4 the word "through" in the second line thereof and inserting
5 in place thereof the word 'such,' and by striking out the
6 words "of the city of Hallowell" in the second line thereof,
7 and by inserting after the word "across" in the third line
8 thereof the word 'such,' and by striking out the word "there-
9 in" in the third line thereof, so that said section, as amended,
10 shall read as follows:

Sect. 4. The said district is hereby authorized to lay in
2 and through such streets, roads, ways and highways and
3 across such private lands, and to maintain, repair and re-

4 place all such pipes, aqueducts, and fixtures as may be neces-
5 sary and convenient for its corporate purposes; and when-
6 ever said district shall lay any pipes or aqueducts in any
7 street, road, way or highway it shall cause the same to be
8 done with as little obstruction as practicable to the public
9 travel, and shall at its own expense without unnecessary
10 delay cause the earth and pavement removed by it to be
11 replaced in proper condition.'
