STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, Providing for an Increase in State Pension for
Ada M. Cowan of Sidney.

Resolved: That there be paid to Ada M. Cowan of Sidney, daughter of a Civil War pensioner, a pension of fifteen dollars per month, payable quarterly, beginning January first, nineteen hundred twenty-five and continuing during the pleasure of the legislature until otherwise ordered, which payment shall be in lieu of any other state pension now provided by law.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Ada M. Cowan is the daughter of a pensioner of the Civil War, who died in February, 1923. She was dependent upon her father for support and is now in destitute circumstances and in need of assistance. She has been receiving \$10 per month.
