STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relative to State of Maine Building at West Spring-
field, Massachusetts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The governor shall nominate and by and with the advice
2 of the council shall appoint the successors to the committee
3 of five which now has and shall hereafter have charge of
4 the erection, operation and management of the building
5 erected by the state under and by virtue of chapter fifty-one
6 of the resolves of nineteen hundred twenty-three, upon the
7 grounds of the Eastern States Agricultural and Industrial
8 Exposition, Inc., at West Springfield, Massachusetts. In
9 making said appointments to said committee the governor

10 and council shall recognize the agricultural, industrial and
11 recreational industries and activities of Maine, but the com-
12 missioner of agriculture ex-officio shall always be the fifth
13 member.
