STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to the University of Maine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The University of Maine is hereby prohibited
2 from continuing its course of Liberal Arts and from con-
3 ferring the Bachelor of Arts degree.

Sect. 2. The institution shall revert to and be limited by
2 the original power granted by chapter five hundred thirty-
3 two of the private and special laws of eighteen hundred
4 sixty-five, wherein the course of instruction was for the
5 benefit of agriculture and the mechanic arts.

Sect. 3. All acts inconsistent with this act are hereby
2 repealed.
