STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Amend that Part of Section Fifty-one of Chapter Eighty-two of the Revised Statutes of Maine Relating to the Regular Sessions of the Supreme Judicial Court Held in and for the County of York.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

So much of section fifty-one of chapter eighty-two of the 2 revised statutes of the state of Maine as relates to the hold- 3 ing of the regular sessions of the supreme judicial court in 4 and for the county of York is hereby amended by striking 5 out the word "Saco" in the first line of said paragraph and 6 substituting therefor the word 'Kennebunk,' so that said 7 portion of said section as amended shall read as follows:

'York, at Kennebunk, on the first Tuesday of January, and
2 at Alfred on the first Tuesday of May and the third Tues-
3 day of September.'
