STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Motor Vehicle Laws.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The governor, with the advice and consent of
2 the council, shall, on or before the first day of January,
3 A. D. nineteen hundred and twenty-six, appoint an official
4 to be known as registrar of motor vehicles, who shall per-
5 form all the duties now imposed upon the secretary of state
6 and highway commission of the state of Maine under the
7 provisions of chapter two hundred and eleven of the public
8 laws of nineteen hundred and twenty-one and acts addi-
9 tional and amendatory thereof at a salary of five thousand
10 dollars per annum. Said registrar to serve for the term of

11 four years from said January first, A. D. nineteen hundred
12 and twenty-six.

Sect. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith
2 are hereby repealed.
