# STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Mary Louise Rowe of Exeter for State Pension.

*Resolved:* That the sum of twelve dollars per month be 2 paid to Mary Louise Rowe, of Exeter, widow of Ambrose 3 Rowe, Civil War veteran, to be paid quarterly from the 4 fund appropriated for military pensions, beginning January 5 first, nineteen hundred twenty-five, and continuing during 6 the pleasure of the legislature.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mrs. Mary Louise Rowe of Exeter, County of Penobscot, aged eighty years, is the widow of Ambrose Rowe, who served during the Civil War in Co. B, 7th, Reg. of Maine Volunteers. She is in poor circumstances and the town of Exeter is now paying Mrs. Rowe's board, as her son is unable financially to support her.
