## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Authorize the State Board of Registration and Examination in Optometry to Issue a Certificate of Registration to David M. House.

Whereas, said David M. House now of Milbridge in County of Washington and State of Maine, was engaged in the actual and continuous practice of optometry in the State of Maine for three years immediately prior to the time when the Act of Nineteen Hundred Nine authorizing the appointment of the State Board of Registration and Examination in Optometry took effect,

And Whereas, said David M. House through ignorance of the provisions of said Act neglected to file his affidavit with said Board and receive his Certificate. And Whereas, until complaint recently made, he has continued in this state the practice of optometry.

And Whereas, his ability to so practice is testified to by a large number of reputable people, but his lack of education prevents his passing an examination before said Board.

Now, in consideration of the fact that it was only his ignorance of the Act that prevented his now being a legal practitioner,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

David M. House of Milbridge in the County of Washing-2 ton and State of Maine, may, on or before ninety days 3 from the time this Act shall take effect, pay to the Treasurer 4 of said Board the sum of five dollars and file affidavit in 5 satisfactory proof that he was engaged in the actual and 6 continuous practice of optometry in the State of Maine 7 for three years immediately prior to the time when the Act 8 of Nineteen Hundred Nine authorizing the appointment of 9 the State Board of Registration and Examination in Optom-10 etry took effect, and thereupon said Board shall issue to 11 said David M. House a Certificate of Registration signed 12 by the President and Secretary of the Board, authorizing 13 him to practice optometry in this state, and said Certificate 14 shall be recorded in the office of the Supreme Judicial Court 15 for the County of Washington, and shall pay said Clerk 16 fifty cents for recording the same, and in the absence of 17 the original certificate an attested copy of such record shall 18 be received as evidence in all courts within the State of the 19 right of said David M. House to practice optometry within 20 the state.
