STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, in Favor of an Appropriation for the Directors of the Port of Portland, for the Payment of Salaries and Expenses.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated to
2 be paid to the directors of the port of Portland, for the
3 fiscal year from July first, nineteen hundred twenty-five, to
4 June thirtieth, nineteen hundred twenty-six, thirty-five hun-
5 dred dollars, of which there shall be applied in payment of
6 the salaries of the directors twenty-five hundred dollars, and
7 for the expenses of the directors, one thousand dollars; and
8 for the fiscal year from July first, nineteen hundred twenty-
9 six, to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred twenty-seven, thirty-

10 five hundred dollars, of which there shall be applied in
11 payment of the salaries of the directors, twenty-five hun-
12 dred dollars, and for the expenses of the directors, one
13 thousand dollars.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

All of the foregoing items were authorized by the Legislature of Maine under and by virtue of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred nineteen, chapter eighty-four, as amended by chapter one hundred twenty-three of the Private and Special Laws of the same year enacted at the special session of the Legislature; the expenses include the disbursements incident to the office of the directors.
