AMENDMENT "A" TO H. P. 258, H. D. 51

---

Said act is hereby amended by adding in section thirty-  
2 eight after the word "thereof" in the twenty-fifth line on  
3 page three, the words: 'in any of the counties of the state  
4 except the county of Aroostook wherein no person shall  
5 during the open seasons above named, except as hereinafter  
6 provided, take, catch, kill or have in possession, whenever  
7 and wherever taken, caught or killed, more than two deer,  
8 or part or parts thereof. A person lawfully killing a deer  
9 in open season shall have a reasonable time in which to  
10 transport the same to his home and may have the same in  
11 possession at his home in close time.'
