## STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Regulate Fishing in East Stream, So-called, in Washington County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. For a period of five years from the time this

- 2 act becomes effective, it shall be unlawful for any person
- 3 to fish for, take, catch or kill any kind of fish at any time
- 4 in East stream, so-called, which stream is situated in the
- 5 towns of Cutler, Whiting and Trescott, in the county of
- 6 Washington. It shall also be unlawful for any person to
- 7 have in possession at any time any kind of fish taken in
- 8 violation of any provision of this section.

- Sect. 2. Whoever violates any provision of this act shall 2 be subject to a penalty of not less than ten dollars nor more 3 than thirty dollars, and costs, for each offense, and an additional penalty of one dollar for each fish taken, caught, 5 killed or had in possession in violation of any provision of 6 this act.
- Sect. 3. In all prosecutions arising under this act, trial 2 justices, police and municipal courts, within their respective 3 jurisdictions, shall have original and concurrent jurisdiction 4 with the supreme judicial court and the superior courts.
