**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE**

AN ACT to Amend Section 18, Chapter 219, Public Laws of 1917, as Amended by Chapter 196, Public Laws of 1919, Chapter 73, Public Laws 1921.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

That section eighteen, chapter two hundred and nineteen 2 of the public laws of nineteen hundred and seventeen, as 3 amended by chapter one hundred and ninety-six, the public 4 laws of nineteen hundred and nineteen and chapter seventy- 5 three, public laws of nineteen hundred and twenty-one, be 6 amended by adding thereto the following:

(a) It shall be lawful for any person to take, catch, or

2 kill smelts and pickerel through the ice on Monday of each
3 week from Snow Pond, so-called, in the Belgrade Lakes
4 chain in Kennebec county.

(b) It shall be lawful for any person to take, catch, or
2 kill smelts and pickerel through the ice on Tuesday of each
3 week from East Pond, so-called, in the Belgrade Lakes
4 chain in Kennebec and Somerset counties.

(c) It shall be lawful for any person to take, catch, or
2 kill smelts and pickerel through the ice on Wednesday of
3 each week from North Pond, so-called, in the Belgrade
4 Lakes chain in Kennebec and Somerset counties.

(d) It shall be lawful for any person to take, catch, or
2 kill smelts and pickerel through the ice on Thursday of each
3 week from Great Pond, so-called, in the Belgrade Lakes
4 chain in Kennebec county.

(e) It shall be lawful for any person to take, catch, or
2 kill smelts and pickerel through the ice on Friday of each
3 week from Long Pond, so-called, in the Belgrade Lakes
4 chain in Kennebec county.

(f) It shall be lawful for any person to take, catch, or
2 kill smelts and pickerel through the ice on Saturday of each
3 week from McGraw & Ellis Pond, so-called, in the Bel-
4 grade Lakes chain in Kennebec county.
